The first two truck companies were assigned to make rescues over ladders of those occupants at windows in the front of the building. Rescue units were assigned the job of triage and treatment of those victims coming down who had suffered smoke inhalation and burns, and caring for the victim who had jumped. The second alarm was transmitted six minutes after the first, at 1035, followed by a third alarm at 1043. Because recovery of the victim...
