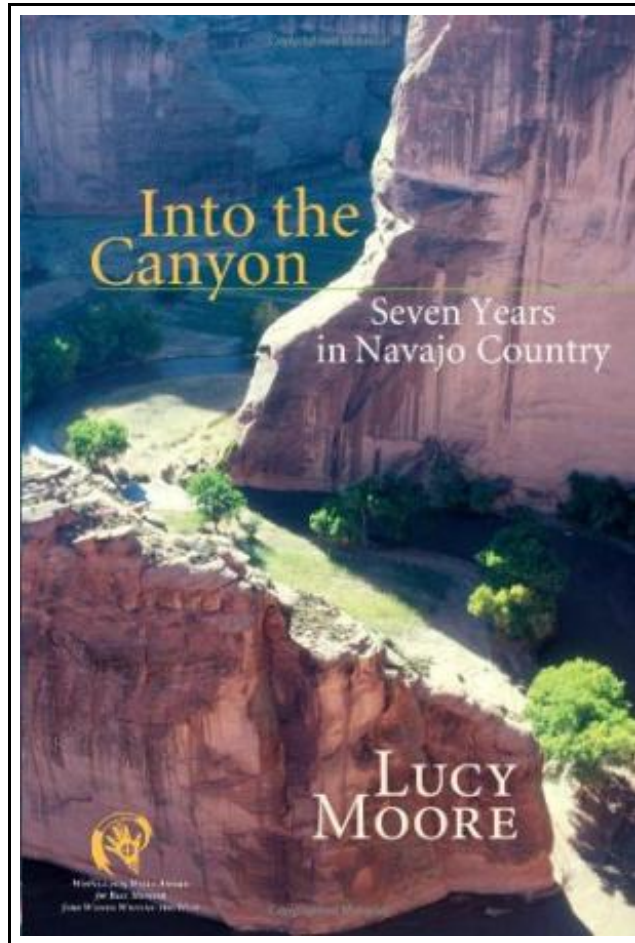

After fulfilling the two-year commitment with the legal program, Lucy and Bob stayed for another five years.
